As mentioned in the last newsletter article, we suspended rink operations this winter due to safety concerns and financial constraints. Unfortunately, COVID restrictions continue to make getting revenue through hall rentals challenging. We made the very difficult decision to also terminate the contract in place for our caretaker and rental agent, Tracey (see the article on page two). We appreciate everyone's patience as we adapt our rental process and hall management moving forward. At this time, board members have taken on the duties and tasks of managing the hall. If there are specific tasks or duties you would

Some examples include (that aren't board positions): checking on the hall/picking up the mail, facilitating rentals/showing the building to potential renters, and check in and check out procedures for renters. It's a great way to be involved with the community and meet new neighbours!
