A MESSAGE FROM THE PARKVIEW COMMUNITY LEAGUE BOARD

Winter Greetings and Happy New Year from PVCL! Our AGM was on October 20, 2020, As mentioned in the previous newsletter, our primary focus was on our 2020/2021 budget. Unfortunately, due to further provincial restrictions specifically on the use of our community hall, our income sources are limited and the projected deficit remains quite high. Additionally, the ORC project has been scaled back given the significantly reduced funds. The scope will now include tearing down current fencing around the rink and tennis court. Then a new rink will be installed a few feet north of current placement, as well as a new shed. The tennis court will remain without a fence, and all exterior lighting would be upgraded. This reduced project will cost approximately \$600,000.

We still have vacancies on our board of directors and welcome new board members (you do not have to join at the AGM). As of December 2020, our president position is currently unfilled.

A big Thank You to Derek Kramer for dedicating his time and efforts towards the community during his presidency! We are also looking for a casino coordinator (slotted for the last quarter of 2021) as Amanda is stepping down from her role as a member-at-large. She will be missed! That being said,

volunteering can be as much or as little of a time commitment as you want. If you have time to spare and would like to get involved, I guarantee we have an appropriate position for you - just send an email!



Since announcing in the last newsletter that this project is proceeding, fundraising and grant writing is now our focus.






