I later moved on to be the Parkview Playschool President and stayed in that capacity a few more years.

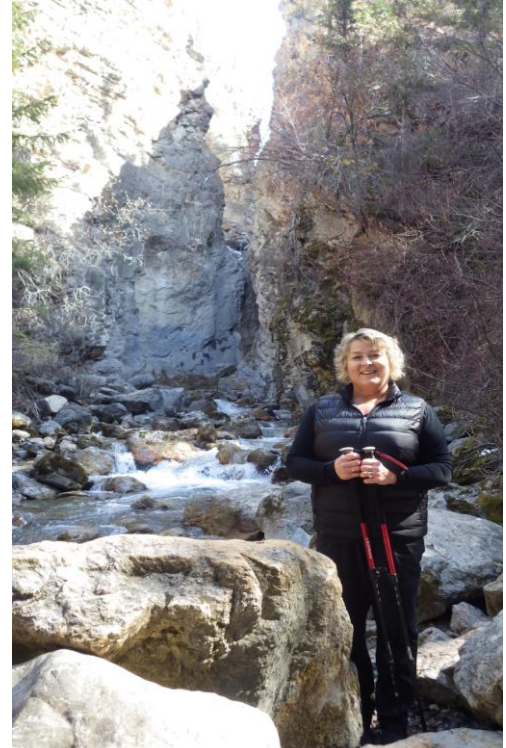
