#### OUTDOOR REDEVELOPMENT UPDATE

It's an exciting time for Parkview, as the Outdoor Redevelopment Committee received approval from the City for the project's concept stage. This includes rehabilitation of the skating rink area to increase its functionality during non-skating months by implementing a sand court area. Modication of the existing tennis courts into a new outdoor open space and social area is also planned. Creating a space and development that caters to all community residents, including more diversity, is a focus.
