Back in 2004, a dynamic group of women came together and formed the Parkview Redevelopment Society (PRS) with the express purpose of replacing the playground and revitalizing the community hall and leased space. The PRS was to create an overall community park space that was inviting to residents of all ages and abilities. Seven years of work have resulted in a large-scale project that has added beauty and value to our community. Together, \$1.8 million dollars was raised and we now wish to thank all donors, volunteer labourers, visionaries, City of Edmonton employees, municipal and provincial government representatives, and community league executive members who have been instrumental in pulling this project together.

If you have been by the Parkview Park recently you will see that there is much to rave about. An exciting new park space has been developed on the south side of the hall. The patio space, complete with space heaters and a built-in gas BBQ, will allow for many

outdoor celebrations in the years to come. There are fantastic new green spaces, walkways, tables, benches, and fire pits tying the hall, parking lot, tennis courts, rinks, basketball courts, and playground areas together. Almost all of this development is the direct result of the countless donations and efforts of committed residents, volunteers, and contractors. Our entire community should be proud of the beautiful park space and amenities now available.

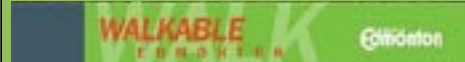

The communities of Parkview, Crestwood and Laurier Heights along with the City of Edmonton have collaborated to produce a map of walking routes in the neighborhood. The designated walking routes are outlined in a descriptive brochure, and guide residents through some of Edmonton's most beautiful mature neighborhoods, natural ravines and our picturesque North Saskatchewan River valley.

On September 17th, Parkview Community will celebrate the Grand Opening of its newly renovated and upgraded community centre. Additions include an outdoor fire pit, walk out patio with canopy and heaters and gas barbecue. The grounds have new landscaping with nice grassy areas and park benches between the hall and playground. Bring the family for a day of family fun.

The grand opening festivities include a petting zoo, clown, face painting and Jumpy Thing complete with a bouncy slide. We will also strike up our new barbecue for hot dogs, and have grand opening cake for dessert.

Walkable Edmonton will join in on the festivities for the official kickoff of the walking routes. Activities and games are scheduled in all three community centres. There will be prizes, free food and refreshments throughout the day. City officials and dignitaries will be on hand for a ribbon cutting ceremony, and to meet and talk with residents.

Parkview Playschool is directed by a volunteer executive and is a sub-group of the Parkview Community League. 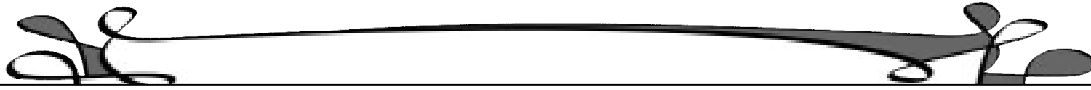

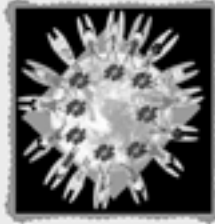

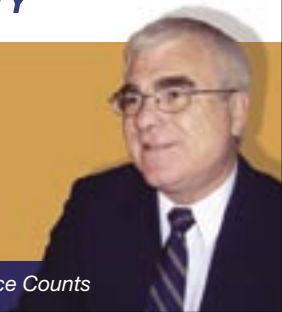
