The year is flying by and it is hard to believe we are already into February. There have been a lot of new faces this year and great friendships are emerging from our weekly gatherings! It is a lot

of fun for the children each week, especially when the weather outside is blistery and cold, be sure to come out and let the kids run off some steam!

Tot Time is an informal drop-in gathering run by parents and caregivers for children up to 4 years old. **Our registration evening for the 2012-2013 school year, was held on February 13, 2012.** Please contact Christine Mallett, our registrar for information about available spots in our great program!

Parkview Playschool (located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Parkview Community Hall) provides programming for 3 and 4-year-old children, primarily from the Parkview and Valleyview communities, although all children are welcome to apply, space permitting. As a parent of the cooperative program, there are a number of expectations:

- Roster duty (approximately once every 14-16 classes)
- One toy wash per year
- Participate in the "Dessert Auction Fundraising Event"
- Participation in special events and/or field trips



### **4-Year-old Program Specifics**

- Children must be four years of age by March 1st, 2013. This is the current entry deadline for the school system.

Class times: Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings from 8:50-11:20  
Cost is \$90.00/month

### **3-Year-old Program Specifics**

- Children must be three years of age and toilet-trained by the first day of school.

Class times: Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 8:50-11:20  
Cost is \$70.00/month

### **3/4 Year-old Program Specifics**

- Children must be three years of age and toilet-trained by the first day of school.
- Children must be four years of age by March 1st, 2013. This is the current entry deadline for the school system.

Class times: Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons from 1:00-3:30  
(4-Year Olds)  
Monday and Wednesday afternoons from 1:00-3:30 (3 Year Olds)  
Cost is \$70.00/month for 3-year-olds and \$90.00/month for 4-year-olds

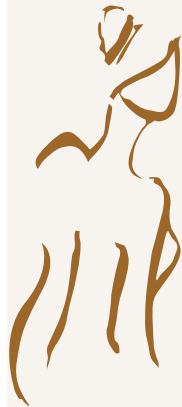
