
PUB NIGHT SUCCESS

MUSICAL PARKVIEW RESIDENT RELEASES TWO ALBUMS

Parkview's Paula Eve Kirman has been busy recording and releasing new music.

In December, Paula released her first professionally-produced, full-length album. *The Crow* features nine original songs that she has been performing at coffee shops, cafés, festivals, and events since 2007. Her musical style is folk/singer-songwriter, and many of the songs have themes of social justice and human rights. The album received a positive review from the *Edmonton Journal* in early January, which stated that Paula is "following in the footsteps of '60s folk singers such as Joan Baez, Bob Dylan and Buffy Sainte-Marie".

She began working on *The Crow* in 2019 with Juno-award winning artist Bill Bourne as producer. It was to be completed in 2020 after Bourne returned from touring, but the pandemic did not allow that to happen. Then, Bourne's failing health prevented him from continuing with the project. Following Bourne's passing in April of 2022, Paula teamed up with local producer, musician, and festival organizer John Armstrong to finish the album. They used the tracks Bourne left with Paula, combined with bringing in numerous musicians, and were even able to include Bourne's own guitar playing on a few songs.

In addition, by the time you read this, Paula's second album should be available online. *Corners* marks a different musical direction for her, as it is has more of a rock/blues feel. The songs still feature Paula's soaring vocals and thoughtful lyrics.

Her music is also on various streaming platforms. *The Crow* is also available as a physical CD featuring original artwork by Paula, and a CD of *Corners* should be available soon as well.
