Exciting Developments from the Street Lab

Turning to an exciting development that has been brewing since last year, the City of Edmonton conducted a Street Lab in our neighbourhood. For those unfamiliar, a Street Lab involves temporary street modifications that aim to enhance pedestrian safety and traffic management. The feedback and data gathered from these interventions have been crucial in shaping the future of our streets. We are thrilled to announce that the results from the Parkview Street Lab are now available and can be accessed here:

<u>https://engaged.edmonton.ca/ParkviewStreetLab</u>. Based on these outcomes, the Safe Mobility engineering team is diligently working on drafting a concept plan specifically for Parkview. This plan is on the cusp of being finalized, and once the engineering plans are stamped, we look forward to the opportunity to connect with you all.

The anticipated installation of the Street Lab enhancements is scheduled for August-September 2024. Rest assured, all residents will receive a public notice in their mail from the City of Edmonton at least two weeks prior to the commencement of work. This notice will outline the specific measures to be implemented. Additionally, a digital copy of this notice will be shared with the Parkview Community League, local schools, and our project update email list to ensure that everyone is kept in the loop.

As we look forward to these developments, let us continue to engage, participate, and shape the future of Parkview together. Your active involvement and feedback are what guide us in making our community a safer, more enjoyable place for everyone.

Wanted: Parkview Community Soccer Coordinator We will not be hosting soccer teams in Parkview for future seasons unless we find a Parkview Community Soccer Coordinator immediately.

Are you passionate about soccer and community engagement? Join us as the Parkview Community Soccer Coordinator and continue the fantastic work already established in our soccer program!

This role is within an established program with equipment and processes in place. Every community who would like host teams must have a soccer coordinator. This current outdoor season will be our current soccer coordinator's last season. We need to know by June 1 if we plan to host indoor teams for the upcoming indoor soccer season.

Responsibilities:

- Distribute equipment to team officials and collect it at the end of the season.
- Manage volunteer team officials.
- Create teams for the outdoor season (indoor season teams are created centrally).
- Attend three meetings per year, hosted by EMSA. These meetings are in the evening.
- Manage the soccer email inbox.
- Manage the EMSA soccer portal (to organize players, teams, and parents).

Requirements:

- General knowledge of soccer gameplay (to distribute equipment).
- Excellent organizational and communication skills.
- Passion for community engagement and fostering a love for soccer.

This role does not include:

- Coordinating field reservations and schedules for practices and games (including make-up games).
- Canceling games due to weather.
- Recruiting team officials.
- Managing referees.
- Organizing team photos.

This part-time position is provided a \$200/month honorarium. Although this is a yearround position, the commitment is flexible. The heaviest time for this position is in October/November and March/April for season start-up. December, July, and August have little to no commitments. This role is approximately 30 hours per year.

This is a great opportunity to make a little extra money, work on your own schedule (mostly at home) and make a huge impact on the Parkview Community. If the position is not filled by June 1, 2024 we will not be hosting future soccer seasons.
