HELLO FROM YOUR PARKVIEW COMMUNITY LEAGUE BOARD!

On behalf of the Parkview Community League Board, we want to begin by thanking everyone who was able to join us at our Annual General Meeting this past November. We were grateful to meet quorum, and even more appreciative of the thoughtful engagement and support shown by residents who care deeply about the future of our community.

Following the AGM, we elected your new Community League Board. A full list of board members and roles is available on our website for anyone who would like to learn more about the volunteers serving the League this year.

As many of you know, the hall is a well-loved and heavily used space, and with age comes the responsibility to plan ahead. We have ratified and begun early planning toward anticipated capital expenditures and maintenance projects we expect will be required over the next three to five years. Taking a proactive approach allows us to protect this shared asset responsibly and transparently, and we will continue to keep the community informed as this work evolves.

We would also like to extend an open invitation to any Parkview Community League member interested in becoming more involved to attend our monthly board meetings. They take place on the third Tuesday of each month at 7:30 p.m., and all members are welcome to attend. These meetings are where volunteers come together to discuss upcoming events, programming, hall operations, and the practical work of keeping the League running. Whether you are curious, passionate about community building, or simply want to listen and learn, you are welcome at the table.

The Parkview Community League operates entirely through volunteer effort. From governance and programming to hall maintenance and events, everything we do is powered by people generously donating their time and skills. Much of our funding is raised through volunteer-led initiatives, including casino fundraisers and other events throughout the year. At the time of writing this, our casino fundraising event was coming up on Jan. 31st and Feb. 1st. Thank you in advance to everyone volunteering. These events are essential to supporting League operations and future investments in the hall.

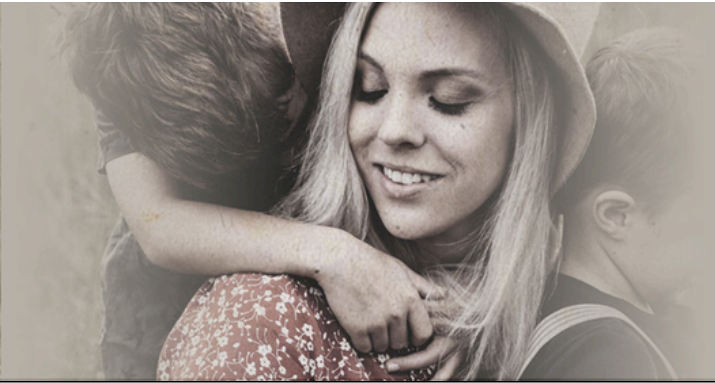

Monday-Thursday evenings are currently booked for programs. However, we have many open time slots available for our community to use.

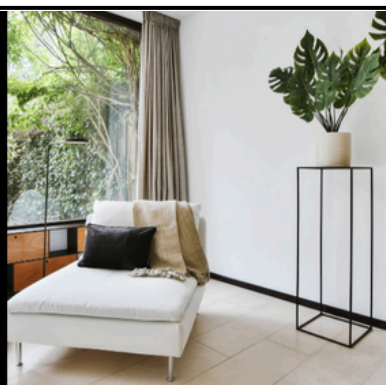

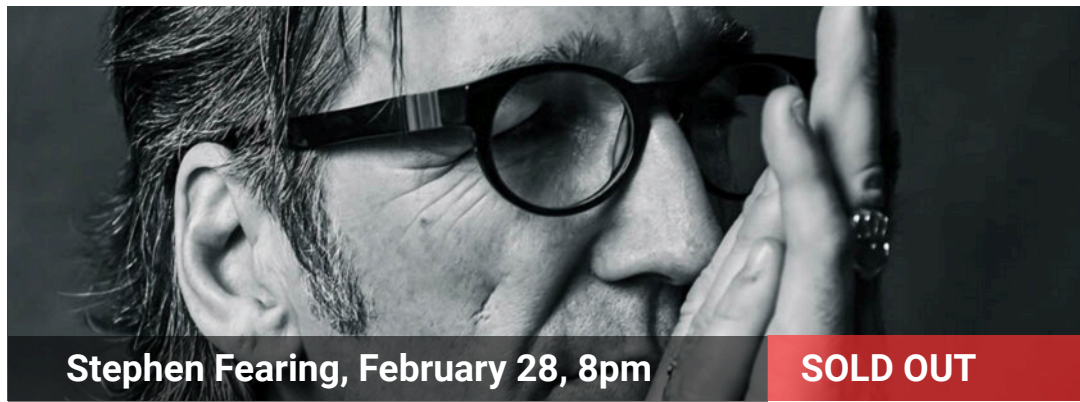

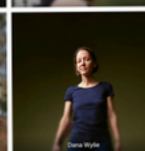
