A bit of planning, some emails, and helping things come together behind the scenes. Time commitment is very manageable throughout the year, with a bit more time closer to the event.

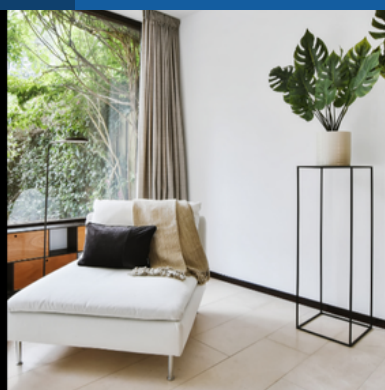

A single developer is reshaping our pocket of Parkview, one bungalow at a time. If nothing changes, blocks you drive past today will be unrecognizable within a few years. This affects your street, too.

WHATS BEING BUILT

14712 88 Ave NW 4-unit row house + 3 secondary suites = 7 rental units (midblock) PERMIT 643945362-002 **DAVACH PROPERTIES**

8714 147 St NW - 4-unit row house + 4 secondary suites = 8 rental units (cornerlot) PERMIT 642509816-002 **DAVACH PROPERTIES**

147XX 88 Ave NW — PURCHASED, NEXTUP
Mid-block bungalow. Same developer. Another 7–8 rental units expected.

87XX 147 St NW — PURCHASED, NEXTUP
Just sold to the same developer.
A fourth property within a 50-metre radius.

87XX 146 St NW — PURCHASED, NEXTUP
Fifth property acquired on an adjacent block.
The pattern is spreading.

This is not NIMBYism. We support thoughtful infill, skinny homes, duplexes, garden suites. We oppose developments that come at the direct personal and financial expense of the neighbours already living here.
